A New Beginning with Journey Home Housing (click image to watch video)



This past spring, an opportunity appeared like a Divine gift when Southwestern Baptist Theological Seminary put several tracts of unused student housing up for sale. Seeing the huge opportunity to create permanent affordable housing for families staying in Morris Foundation Family Services Center, as well as from other agencies in the area, we acted quickly to purchase the property. This property is now part of Journey Home Housing, an enterprise by Presbyterian Night Shelter to provide affordable housing to families and individuals alike.

"We believe this was a once-in-a-lifetime opportunity," said Toby Owen, CEO of Presbyterian Night Shelter, "and I am so incredibly grateful to our donors who believed in that vision to create housing for families. They stepped up and helped make this happen in record time."

Upon closing of the property in July, work began immediately to revive the 42 2-bedroom units; fresh paint, new ceiling fans and fixtures, new roofs, plumbing repairs, and more have given the units renewed life, and tenants have already begun signing leases and moving into Journey Home Housing -Seminary.

While the Seminary Journey Home Housing property is the first to be occupied by tenants, it will not be the last, with plans for other such properties.

"Housing is the biggest solution to ending homelessness." Owen continues, "We want to replicate this model throughout Fort Worth. The vision for the Presbyterian Night Shelter is to move in this direction, where we provide longterm housing to help end the cycle of homelessness for families and individuals. I believe this will be a standard for the Shelter as we move forward."

In addition to affordable rent, tenants can access support from on-site case management and wrap-around services that promote housing stability and general well-being.



For Michael, a single dad, Journey Home Housing has provided muchneeded relief for him and his two young sons. The family has dealt with housing insecurity since 2020, as their resources have gone toward paying for surgeries and medical care for one of the boys; rising rents have only compounded their situation.

"[It gives] some peace of mind," he says as he sits on the stoop of his new home, his arm protectively draped around his youngest son, "maybe hope for the future, you know what I mean? It's not a tunnel without light at the end - if that makes sense. It's stability for my boys, and that's really what we need right now."

We anticipate having full occupancy at our Journey Home Housing – Seminary by spring 2024 as we work to transition families staying at our Morris Foundation Family Services Center into permanent housing.

We are so grateful to our faithful, steadfast donors who made this project possible and are excited at the prospect of expanding our Journey Home Housing enterprise in the months and years to come.
